Dear Mr. Herman:

This letter is to notify you that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received Lake City Army Ammunition Plant's (LCAAP) Class 1 permit modification notice, dated October 12, 2009. The notification was for the following modifications:

1. Part B, Section G, "Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures," to reflect the addition of Mr. T.A. Aggson as a member of the Emergency Response Team;
2. Part B, Section G, "Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures," to reflect the addition of Mr. Dave Cross as a member of the Emergency Spill Response Team;
and
3. Part B, Section G, "Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures," update to Table G-IV., "Listing of Equipment and Material Available for Use on a Spill."

The Department agrees with LCAAP that this is a Class 1 permit modification not requiring prior director approval. LCAAP must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii). LCAAP sent a mailing list letter dated October 13, 2009, and the Department received our copy on October 19, 2009.
