Dear Ms. Casey:

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received Lake City Army Ammunition Plant's (LCAAP) Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated April 8, 2013. The notification was to replace the existing baghouse associated with the Explosive Waste Incinerator with a functionally equivalent baghouse.

The Department agrees with LCAAP that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. LCAAP must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). LCAAP must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
