Dear Mr. Renfroe:

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) hereby approves Solvent Recovery, LLC's (SRC's) Class 2 Permit Modification request, dated August 6, 2014, with conditions. The request was to modify the arrangement of hazardous waste storage areas in the facility, moving permitted storage capacity from an upper floor in the building to the ground floor. The storage capacity in Room B on the first floor, which would include Room B and Room C in SRC's 2005 Missouri Hazardous Waste Management Facility Part I Permit, would increase by 11,880 gallons, from 8,250 gallons to 20,130 gallons. The storage capacity in the fourth floor storage area would decrease by 12,045 gallons, from 18,865 gallons to 6,820 gallons. The change in total storage capacity for the facility would decrease by 165 gallons.

Our decision is based on a thorough technical review of the modification request and applicable federal and state laws and regulations. We are approving the Class 2 Permit Modification request with the following conditions:

1. Room B now includes the former Room B, Room C, and Paint Related Materials Unit and associated secondary containment. Within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter, SRC shall submit a new map reflecting the changes, delineating storage areas and subareas for this room.
2. The maximum amount of hazardous wastes that may be stored in Room B is 366 fifty-five gallon containers or 20,130 gallons, whichever is less.
3. The maximum amount of hazardous wastes that may be stored on the fourth floor storage area is 124 fifty-five gallon containers or 6,820 gallons, whichever is less.



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SRC conducted the public participation activities for the Class 2 Permit Modification request, as described in Code of State Regulations [10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(D)], which incorporates the Code of Federal Regulations [40 CFR 270.42(b)]. The 60-day public comment period began November 7, 2014, and ended on January 6, 2015. SRC held a public meeting about the modification request on December 9, 2014. The Department did not receive any comments on the modification request during the public comment period. The Department mailed a notification letter to everyone on the facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government, as required in 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(D), which incorporates 40 CFR 270.42(f)(1). The notification letter is included with this letter.

The approved Class 2 Permit Modifications are effective immediately. Please be aware that any parties adversely affected or aggrieved by the Department's decision to approve the Class 2 Permit Modifications may be entitled to pursue an appeal before the Administrative Hearing Commission, according to 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(D), which incorporates 40 CFR 270.42(f)(2). The petition must be filed with the Administrative Hearing Commission by March 9, 2015, according to the procedures outlined in 10 CSR 25-2.020 and Missouri Revised Statutes, Sections 260.395.11 and 621.250, RSMo. If the petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed. If it is sent by any other method, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the Administrative Hearing Commission. Appeals must be sent to the Administrative Hearing Commission, Truman State Office Building, Room 640, 301 West High Street, P.O. Box 1557, Jefferson City, MO 65102, or by fax to (573) 751-5018.
