The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) hereby approves Exide's Class 1 Permit Modification request, dated April 17, 2013, without changes. The request was to extend the interim compliance date on the Missouri Hazardous Waste Management Facility (MHWMF) Permit dated September 23, 2009. The interim compliance date in the MHWMF's Schedule of Compliance for Landfill #2's Phase II construction to begin was September 23, 2013, and we are extending this date to May 23, 2014.

The Construction Quality Assurance Plan for Phase II construction of Landfill #2 was also attached with this Class 1 modification request. Please submit this document under separate cover for tracking purposes.

Exide must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the date of this letter, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1) and modified by 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(A)6 and 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(B)10. Exide must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
