This letter is to notify you that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received BASF's Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated June 10, 2010. The notification was to update the "Emergency Coordinator Table" in Section 12, of the Contingency Plan of the plant's Part B application.

The Department agrees with BASF that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. BASF must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). BASF must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
