The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received BASF's Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated December 20, 2012. The notification was to update the emergency coordinator's contact list in the contingency plan.

The Department agrees with BASF that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. BASF must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). BASF shall also update the contingency plans held by local police, fire, hospitals, and State and local emergency response teams.
