This letter is to notify you that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received Continental Cement Company, LLC/Green America Recycling, LLC's (CCC/GAR) Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated February 15, 2011. The request was to replace existing liquid burner fuel lines and recirculation lines with functionally equivalent equipment.

The Department agrees with CCC/GAR that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval. CCC/GAR must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). CCC/GAR must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
