Dear Mr. Lanzafame:

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources has reviewed Buick Resource Recycling Facility, LLC's (BRRF)'s Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated October 22, 2013, and agrees with BRRF that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval per 40 CFR 270.42 (d)(2)(i), incorporated by reference in 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). The notification was to modify the planned openings in the old Blast Furnace Feed Storage Building previous vehicle entrance to leave a standard man-sized door in the right hand corner of the current opening and modify the opening in the Battery Sulfurization Neutralization Building by covering the opening with a plastic strip style closure or similar material instead of a hinged plate.

BFFR must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as outlined in 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in 10 CSR 25-7.270(1). BFFR must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
