This letter is to notify you that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) reviewed Lone Star Industries' Class 1 Permit Modification request, dated December 6, 2010. The request was to update the current Subpart BB Inspection Forms at the facility to include the changes incurred to Tank #1 during repairs. The Department found the information in the Subpart BB Inspection Forms to be complete.

The Department agrees with Lone Star Industries that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification requiring prior director approval. We are approving the modification request.

Lone Star Industries must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the date of this letter, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii), incorporated by reference in Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1).
