Dear Mr. Zoghby:

This letter is to notify you that the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) reviewed EBV Explosives Environmental Company's (EBVEEC) Class 1 permit modification request, dated September 1, 2009. The request was for revisions to the entrance gate, access roads, office building, and water system. Additionally, the request is for the building of a new entrance and office building at 4174 County Road 180, north of the current entrance. The new entrance will have a guard house and holding area for visitors and incoming and outgoing trucks. Sections of the permit application have been revised to reflect the new address and access routes. A new Part A has been submitted with the modification request to reflect the new address.

The Department agrees with EBVEEC that this is a Class 1 permit modification requiring prior director approval. We are approving the modification request. EBVEEC must send a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the date of this letter, as outlined in Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii). EBVEEC must send a copy of the notice to the Department.
