The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Department) received EBV Explosives Environmental Company's (EBV) Class 1 Permit Modification notice, dated March 9, 2015. The notification was to update the evacuation map in the contingency/emergency plan.

The Department agrees with EBV that this is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring prior director approval, according to Code of State Regulations 10 CSR 25-7.270(1), which incorporates Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42, Appendix I, A.1. and B.6.d. EBV sent a notice of the modification to everyone on their facility mailing list and the appropriate units of state and local government within 90 calendar days after the change was put into effect, as required by 10 CSR 25-7.270(1) and 10 CSR 25-7.270(2)(A)6, which incorporates and modifies 40 CFR 270.42(a)(1)(ii). On June 23, 2015, the Department received a copy of the notice, dated June 18, 2015.
