The Missouri Department of Natural Resources invites the public to an informational meeting to learn about a request for proposals for natural resource restoration in the Kansas City and Springfield, Missouri areas. The meetings are scheduled as follows:

Department representatives will be on hand to present information on a request for proposals to restore or benefit natural resources including groundwater, riparian corridors, streams, floodplains and wetlands in the Kansas City and Springfield areas. Funding for the restoration projects comes from the bankruptcy and related litigation involving Anadarko and Tronox.

The Department developed the Missouri Statewide Groundwater Restoration Plan (MSGRP) to guide the implementation of restoration and protection projects that address injuries to the state's groundwater. Eligible projects should restore, protect and preserve the state's groundwater resources.
