This grant will also fund the creation of a district electronic library and database, holding monthly meetings, and preparing financial reports and the assessment inventory. This event aims to reduce the amount of household hazardous waste (HHW) citizens in the city/county have stored on their property that may otherwise be disposed of improperly. Citizens will be able to bring their HHW to Camdenton's High School parking lot where it can be disposed of properly.

This grant pays for the two contracts, advertising, and personnel to staff the drop-off locations, to monitor correct usage and to assist the public with their recycling needs. The City of Lebanon maintains a HHW collection trailer and contracts to recycle/dispose of the HHW. The City of Lebanon has a yard waste site for its citizens and provides them with the compost from the site.

The conveyor will carry the shredded paper into the baler, eliminating the need for employees to lift containers into the baler, which is a much safer process.

The dumpster will be available to the public to bring "white goods" (wasters, dryers, hot water heaters) for proper management. The availability of the dumpster will be publicized through local news media in advance of the collection day to allow the public ample time to arrange transportation of items to the disposal site. These funds will also be used to reclaim refrigerants, personnel on site as well as the cost of hauling the "white goods" for proper management.
