This grant provides for the day to day operations of Region O.

Computer Recycling will use the truck to pickup larger loads and loads which need a dock height truck due to access, to efficiently travel longer distances for pickups/collections and eliminate loading and unloading necessary with the use of their van height 14 foot box truck. Computer Recycling provides recycling for electronic devices in the Springfield area.

Grant funds shall only be used for recycling carts and not trash carts pursuant to 10 CSR 80-9.050(2)(B)6.

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O2014-004	Urban Districts Alliance Urban Districts Alliance: Springfield Downtown Glass Recycling Greene	CC	RE	\$0.00 \$41,564.00 \$0.00 \$0.00	Ms. Barb Baker	This grant funds for Urban Districts Alliance: a primary contractor for \$25,376 to collect glass in downtown Springfield and drop it off at the Springfield Service Center, to rinse the glass recycling containers and return to businesses immediately, to contact new business owners and managers regarding recycling glass, to maintain glass recycling containers, to keep records of glass collected and required reports, a secondary contractor for \$12,688 to provide coverage for sick, holidays or vacation time for the primary contractor, a tablet for the UDA for \$500 to monitor the glass recycling of the contractors, recycling containers for \$2,000 at \$40 each, and miscellaneous supplies including stickers, signs and window clings for \$1,000. Grant funds shall only be used for recycling containers and not trash containers pursuant to 10 CSR 80-9.050(2)(B)6.

Big Dog Recycling has just begun its recycling processing and will be assisting the Polk County recycling facility and has made a proposal to the City of Buffalo to help with their program. In addition, Big Dog Recycling has been asked by nine (9) Bolivar businesses and schools to pickup their cardboard for recycling.
