This grant will also fund continuation of district's electronic library and database, monthly meetings, and preparing financial reports and the assessment inventory.
T2014-002	City of Osage Beach City of Osage Beach Annual White Goods Recycling Event Camden & Miller	CC	RE	\$1,850.00 \$0.00 \$0.00 \$300.00	Ms. Juanita Woods	This grant funds advertising for the white goods recycling event for \$100, reclamation of Freon (\$80 per unit x 25 units) for \$2,000 and fuel for PW equipment for \$50. The program income is estimated at \$300 from the recycling of the white goods. Personnel costs are donated along with the roll-off dumpster rental. The City of Osage Beach will provide a drop-off site for white goods disposal for two weeks which allows the public time to arrange transport to the site. The goal is to recycle white goods and prevent illegal dumping on the lake environment.

The purchase of a newer box truck will allow Gateway Industries to travel greater distances for the recovery of more recyclable commodities. Gateway Industries has collection bins at schools, churches, businesses, Eldon post office and on-site for drop-off any time day or night. Gateway is an extended employment sheltered workshop.

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T2014-004	City of Lebanon Lebanon's Recycling Program District-wide	CC	WR, RE,CO	\$49,777.34 \$0.00 \$0.00 \$0.00	Ms. Melissa Myers	This project partially funds an expansion of household hazardous waste (HHW) services for the district using the City of Lebanon facility and provides for one additional HHW and other recyclables collection at a satellite event in Camden or Miller counties, partially funds participation in the Earth Day annual recycling race, participation in the Lebanon Home Show, advertising for these events and collections, and development and printing of an information guide to recycling. The grant partially funds personnel for the: Lebanon HHW operation, a satellite collection event, the annual recycling event, and public relation booth at the Lebanon's Home Show for \$14,891.53 and fringe for \$13,152.79, HHW contracts for \$19,808.82, paper stock and printing a recycling information guide for \$709.20 and advertising for \$1,215.00 with the remainder of the personnel, fringe, contractual services, advertising and supplies paid from match. Match support is also provided for Laclede Industries to allow the residents of the district to drop-off recyclables (paper, glass, plastic, cardboard and tin) for recycling.

Lake Area Industries is a sheltered workshop. They use their leased baler to bale recyclables including: textiles, corrugate and secured paper documents for destruction. This grant would allow Lake Area Industries to purchase either the leased baler or a substitute baler for the leased baler.
