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## Appendix IV.

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### GRANT REVIEW POLICIES

1. District Grant Applications will be reviewed and ranked by a three member Sub-Committee appointed by the Chairperson of the Executive Board. The ranking will be based on the objective, point-based criteria developed by the District staff and Executive Board. No Executive Board Member shall participate in the ranking of an application submitted by their jurisdiction, agency or organization. Following the ranking, the Executive Board may invite the applicants, in order of ranking and as many as could possible be awarded based upon the requests, to make a brief presentation before the Executive Board. Applicants should be prepared to justify their project and answer questions pertinent to its award. Upon completion of the Sub-Committee presentation and recommendation to the Executive Board, the Executive Board will determine the degree to which funding to any project will adversely affect existing entities in the market segment and assign the final ranking and/or funding of the received applications.

The final decision on the grant awards shall be made by vote of the Executive Board.

2. District grant funds shall not be awarded for projects in a City or County which has not adopted the Southwest Missouri Solid Waste Management District Solid Waste Plan.
3. Projects generally will not be funded on an on-going basis, but will be funded to encourage the creation or start-up of programs. Partial funding may be provided in future years where funds are available and need is documented.

The District Plan may provide recommendations for on-going projects which are selected for special funding consideration by the district for a given year.

4. The past grant administration performance of an applicant shall be considered for on-going projects and for applications for different projects from the same applicant.
