4. (A) WHAT WASTE REDUCTION GOALS DID THE DISTRICT HAVE FOR THE MOST RECENTLY COMPLETED FISCAL YEAR AND WHAT ACTIONS DID THE DISTRICT TAKE TO ACHIEVE THESE GOALS?

Districts goal is to always maintain high volume of recycle products not going into the waste stream, with the Sheltered Workshops and Community owned recycle trailers (purchased with grant funds) numbering 39 in the District and excellant community participation District as been able to reduce that flow from the landfill.
The District Tire Roundup not being funded has resulted in tires accumulating in yards and being thrown in the ditches, and lots of inquiries from the small communitiees leaders as what can the District do to help. Believe the cost per ton and unavailable haulers may make this project cost prohibitive anyway.
In place of the Tirre Roundup the District initiated a E-Waste Project which was successful in one County, Very Successful in one County and not good in two counties. Will not persue this Project in the new Cycle.

With the additon of the PPI (Sheltered Workshop Pemiscot County) we should show a signigicant reduction, during the current cycle the Dist purchased them a Shredder and awarded a grant for the upcoming cycle for general operatons.
We have some inquireies from the communities without recycling trailers wanting to participate in the coming cycle as well as some counties interested in Shredders for the County, to be used by any governmental entity as well as schools who might have a need for shredding materials, this too shoul increase tonnage from waste stream. District will be working and guinding those interested.

1. 3% to 5% was hoped for and exceeded with reporting of additional tonnage from added Workshop. Workshop that was closed due to burn out back in business resulting in increase.
2. Furnished funds for general operations, purchased two shredders, recycling trailer.
