A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT IN JOINING THE NORTHEAST MISSOURI SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT, REGION C

WHEREAS, on July 9, 1990, Missouri Governor John Ashcroft signed Senate Bill 530, now known as Missouri's solid waste management law, which is designed to foster local government cooperation to reduce the volume of landfill solid waste in Missouri by 40 percent by 1998; and

WHEREAS, as a means to facilitate this local government cooperation, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources has divided the state into multi-county regions as of July 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, counties within these regions may form regional solid waste management districts to help them meet the law's 40 percent waste reduction goal; and

WHEREAS, the County of Adair has studied the feasibility of joining with its neighbor counties in maintaining a solid waste management district in the Northeast Missouri Region;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Adair County Commissioners voted unanimously on December 21, 1992 to join the Northeast Missouri Solid Waste District Region C in order to come into compliance with Senate Bill # 530.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Board of the Northeast Missouri Solid Waste Management District was contacted by the telephone during the week of December 28, 1992, to consider the Adair County petition to join the District. The Executive Board recommended accepting the Adair County petition to join the Northeast Missouri Solid Waste Management District.
