Annual Executive Board and Staff Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form

It is the policy of District J – Quad Lakes Solid Waste Management District that all Executive Board, Advisory Committee members and staff conscientiously avoid conflicts of interest between the interests of the District, and their personal, professional, and business interests. This includes avoiding potential and actual conflicts of interest.

I understand the purpose of this policy is to protect the integrity of the District's decision-making process, to enable our constituencies to have confidence in our integrity and to protect the integrity and reputations of Executive Board members and staff. On an annual basis, I will a full, written disclosure of interest, relationships, and holding that could potentially result in a conflict of interest. This written disclosure will be kept on file, and I will provide an update on an annual basis.

In the course of meeting and/or activities, I will disclose any interests in a transaction or decision where I (including my business or other nonprofit affiliations), my family and/or my significant other, employer, or close associates will receive a benefit or gain. After disclosure, I understand that I will be asked to leave the room for the discussion and will not be permitted to vote on the question.

I understand that this policy is meant to supplement good judgment, and I will respect its spirit as well as its wording.

This policy assists in ensuring District J's compliance with the Solid Waste Management District Grant Rule at 10 CSR 80-9.050(7)(C), Executive Board Accountability and the District J conflict of interest policy.

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

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
