

**Ozark Rivers Solid Waste Management District
Resolution 2008-1**

WHEREAS, Section 610.023.1, RSMo, provides that a public governmental body is to appoint a custodian to maintain that body's records and the identity and location of the custodian is to be made available upon request; and

WHEREAS, Section 610.026, RSMo, sets forth that a public governmental body shall provide access to and, upon request, furnish copies of the public records; and

WHEREAS, Section 610.028.2, RSMo, provides that public governmental body shall provide a reasonable written policy in compliance with sections 610.010 to 610.030, RSMo, commonly referred to as the Sunshine Law, regarding the release of information on any meeting, record or vote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Meramec Regional Planning Commission, currently contracted as administrator for the Ozark Rivers Solid Waste Management District (ORSWMD), be and hereby is appointed custodian of the records of the Ozark Rivers Solid Waste Management District and that such custodian is located at 4 Industrial Drive, St. James, MO 65559.
2. That said custodian shall respond to all requests for access to or copies of a public record within the time period provided by statute except in those circumstances authorized by statute.
3. That the fees to be charged for access to or furnishing copies of records shall be as hereinafter provided: 10 cents per page 9 x 14 or smaller plus an hourly fee for duplicating time not to exceed the hourly rate of pay for clerical staff. Time spent researching requests will be charged at actual cost.
4. That it is the public policy of the ORSWMD that meetings, records, votes, actions and deliberations of this body shall be open to the public unless otherwise provided by law.
5. That the ORSWMD shall comply with sections 610.010 to 610.030, RSMo, the Sunshine Law as now existing or hereafter amended.
