


How to Find Us:

Clean cans preferred.
Other clean aluminum items
accepted.

BROWN PAPER BAGS

Clean and dry.

CARDBOARD

Corrugated, broken-down boxes.
Please no waxed boxes.

GLASS

Whole jars and bottles only.
Clear, green, or brown.

MAGAZINES / PHONEBOOKS

Clean and Dry.

NEWSPAPER / OFFICE PAPER

Clean and Dry.

PLASTIC MILK OR SODA BOTTLES -

#1 AND #2

Clean plastic milk and soda
bottles only.
Please remove lids.

STEEL (TIN CANS)

Clean.
