Current Cleanup Strategies

(All Strategies Are One-Time Events)

- **Tire Dump Roundup**
- **Solid Waste Management District Staging Areas**
- **City & County Staging Areas**
- **“20,000 Strategy”**
- **Enforcement Strategy**



Current Totals – All Strategies

- **Tires Cleaned Up - 15,567,880**
- **900 sites cleaned up**
- **Known Tires Remaining – 319,677**
- **Estimated Unknown Tires – 1/2 million**

Tire Dump Roundup

- **Press Release issued Nov. 2006**
- **Cleanups began in Dec. 2006**
- **MVE conducts cleanups**
- **274 sites reported**
- **193 sites cleaned up - 865,385 tires.**
- **Maintain approx. 300,000 tires “balance”**
- **Ongoing press releases (usually monthly)**



City/County/SWMD Cleanups

- **Completed cleanups (15)**

 - **Ralls County – 13,781**
 - **Pettis County – 5,232**
 - **City of Eldon – 5,335**
 - **City of Fredericktown – 10,751**
 - **City of Linneus – 19,493**
 - **City of Mosby – 200**
 - **City of Seymour – 8,733**
 - **Queen City – 6,531**

 - **TOTAL TIRES: 173,149**

Nonprofit Cleanups

- **Statute allows for nonprofit groups to clean up tires and be reimbursed by the fund**
- **SWMP encourages participation**
- **173 Events – 292,210 tires cleaned up**
- **46 events applied for – 56,306 tires estimated**
