8. Ripple Glass Presentation

Presented by Donna Utter of Ripple Glass

- Collect glass to make cullet, company from Kansas City
- Opportunity for city, county or district to participate in collecting glass
- Grind glass to a final product of fine grain
- Set up transportation from your area for 25 tons
- Discussed process, corks, labels, rings not an issue, no segregation by color, all one container.
- Optical sorter for color, etc. if need
- Owens Corning insulation and Boulevard Brewery two of their customers

- Able to use cullet from own community, many industries were using cullet from other areas of the country
- 5% recycling glass in KC area increased to 18%. National rate 24%
- Weather does not hurt the glass, approximately 4000 years to affect it, can stockpile outside
- Can take jars, bottles, window panes, cannot take pottery, Pyrex, porcelain, ceramics or mirrors. They do not melt

- Gave some history of state conservation, solid waste laws, natural resources
- SWAB created 1990, 1993 MORA established
- Assist State government agencies obtaining recycled content materials goods
- Collection of recyclables, 114 counties
- Recycling committee meets 2-3 times a year, help build recycling in government
