## **Investigation of Odor Control Technologies – 4th Quarter 2015**

This Update on Odor Control Technology Investigation is being submitted by Bridgeton Landfill, LLC (“Bridgeton Landfill”) pursuant to Paragraph 27(C) of the Second Amendment to the First Agreed Order.

Bridgeton Landfill continues to execute state of the art odor control methodologies in the effort to minimize the potential for any off-site emission of odor. This has included continued investigation of new odor control technologies. In the fourth quarter of 2015 Bridgeton Landfill specifically focused this investigation on reviewing competitive vendor alternatives to currently utilized odor control products.
