**5. SWMP Update - Given by Chris Nagel**

- Red Tape Reduction – Currently working on seven rule amendments and those filings will likely occur the first part of June.
- Mixed paper is down and in some areas are reporting as low as \$5 per ton.
- Plastics seems to be staying steady.
- If anyone sees any good reports on commodity prices related to recyclables please let us know we would like to share them with the board.
- Attachment will be included for all House Bills, Senate Bills, and CSRs.
- Brady Wilson – HB 1472 Disposal of Pharmaceuticals, does anyone know what would be proper disposal?
  - Bill requires DHSS and DNR to assist in the development of guidance on proper management.
  - To move from people flushing medicines is part of the take back programs purpose.
  - Take back programs are not allowed in pharmacies in MO and this is designed to address that prohibition (mainly for opioids).
