## District I - East Central Missouri Solid Waste Management District

### SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT ANNUAL REPORT

1 (a). What waste goals did the district have for the fiscal year period and what actions did the districts take to achieve these goals?

The East Central Missouri Solid Waste Management District - Region I Executive Board and its Advisory Council have identified needs within the region and work to address these needs as funding allows. In April 2010, the four counties in the district collaborated to establish the East Central Missouri Recycling Center. Centrally located, the facility serves all counties in the region and has allowed the district to efficiently address as many needs as possible. The facility accepts a variety of items, including electronics and scrap tires. The Executive Board and has made the continued operation of the East Central Missouri Recycling Center a priority. In the grant for operation of the facility, it was estimated that 200 tons of material would be diverted from the waste stream. This estimate was exceeded.

1 (b). What waste goals does the district have for the upcoming fiscal period and what actions does the district plan to take to achieve these goals. Please include the types of grant proposals that will be sought for the upcoming period to assist in meeting these goals.

Because the East Central Missouri Recycling Center has proven to be an effective and economical way to address identified needs in the district, its operation will continue to be a priority. The Region I Executive Board has approved funding a grant for this purpose which will run through June 30, 2020. It is estimated that the facility will divert 200 tons of waste from landfills. Staff will continue to inform residents about the existence of the recycling center and the items accepted. Information about the facility will also be posted online and updated, when needed. Grant proposals for solid waste reuse, reduction, recycling and resource recovery, as well as for facilitating the use of materials collected for recycling will be sought.

2 (a). What recycling goals did the district have for the fiscal year period and what actions did the district take to achieve these goals?

	GOAL:	ACTION:
1	Improve convenience of recycling services and programs.	The Region I Executive Board recognizes that the East Central Missouri Recycling Center has been very valuable in the district's efforts to improve recycling services and programs and approved a grant application for continued operations. The facility is available for residents in all four counties within the region, giving them access to one location that accepts a wide variety of materials year round including paper, cardboard, glass, plastics, metals, clothing/textiles, electronics, white goods, fluorescent bulbs, waste oil and scrap tires. Having one location to take all of these items makes recycling much more convenient for residents. Many residents live outside city limits and do not have access to curbside programs so the facility gives them the opportunity to recycle. In addition, the recycling center accepts several items not typically accepted in curbside programs.
2	Electronics recycling.	The East Central Missouri Recycling Center accepts electronics during hours of operation all through the year. Residents do not have to wait for (or possibly miss) a special collection. Fees are charged for monitors and televisions. If one of the cities within the district decides to organize its own electronics recycling event, district staff support these efforts by sharing information online.
3	Scrap tires	Staff worked with the Missouri DNR Scrap Tire Unit and began accepting scrap tires at the East Central Missouri Recycling Center in 2012. Tires are accepted from residents and a fee is charged. Residents in the Region I District are able to drop off scrap tires during hours of operation throughout the year.

2 (b). What recycling goals does the district have for the upcoming fiscal year period and what actions does the district plan to take to achieve these goals? Please include the types of grant proposals that will be sought for the upcoming period to assist in meeting these goals?

At this time, the Region I Executive Board sees the continued operation of the East Central Missouri Recycling Center as a priority. A variety of items are able to be recycled year round for all residents of the region. The Region I Board has approved a grant for continued operations through June 30, 2020. It is estimated that 200 tons of material will be diverted from the waste stream and recycled. This will include all items accepted by the recycling center. Other grant proposals for recycling will be accepted.

3 (a). What resource recovery goals did the district have for the fiscal year period and what actions did the district take to achieve thee goals?

Operation of the East Central Missouri Recycling Center and recovering recyclables has been the main goal of the district. This was successfully achieved with the board's approval of a grant for that purpose.

3 (b). What resource recovery goals does the district have for the upcoming fiscal year period and what actions does the district plan to take to achieve thee goals? Please include the types of grant proposals that will be sought for the upcoming period to assist in meeting these goals.

The Region I District plans for continued operation of the East Central Missouri Recycling Center. This appears to be the most efficient use of district funding. Staff will explore additional opportunities for resource recovery, should funding allow.
