

(1) Permits-General

- Cost of Compliance
 - Required under RSMO 644.145.2 the adoption of procedures
- Integrated Planning
 - Language being updated to allow additional flexibility and not as prescriptive
- Electronic Reporting
 - Electronic submittal of DMRs and other required permits required
 - Has a fiscal cost to DNR and the public
 - Waivers allowed for religious communities

(2) Continuing Authority

- Addition of not for profits (393s)
- Definition of Availability
 - Waiver from higher level
 - Cost of Connection vs. Cost to upgrade
 - Distance
- How to obtain Level 2 Authority from CWC
 - Capital Improvements Plan
 - Public Hearing held by the utility
 - Public notice the request

(3) Antidegradation

- Complete Antidegradation application requirements
 - Fees
 - Geohydrological Evaluation
 - Evaluation of no-discharge systems
 - Social economic conditions discussion

(4) Construction Permits

- Complete Application
 - Electronic submittal of 1 copy
- Exemptions from Construction Permitting
- Sewer Extension General Permit
 - MOGC has been in effect since April 2015

- Default 2 year Construction Permits
- Statement of Work Complete
 - Removal of Letters of Approval
 - SOWC form

(5) Supervised Authority

- Sewer Extension Authority established in existing rule
 - 9 existing communities
- Treatment Plant Authority established by statute
- Reevaluate Authority at Operating Permit Renewal every 5 years
- Details what needs submitted for a new program and what needs at the renewal

(6-10) Operating Permits

- Details what is a complete application
- Corrects conflict between statute and existing rule for general permits
- Update connection language to match operating permits and references back to Continuing Authority
- For long expired operating permits, ability to request an updated application
- Transferring permits added language from federal rules for expired permits

(11) Closure of Treatment Facilities

- Lagoon & Mechanical Closure
- Closure Plan required to be submitted & approved before closing
- Plans need to include discussion of: sludge removal, concrete removal, site grading, & vegetated growth

(13) General Operating Permits

- The department may require a facility to have coverage under a general permit unless the facility provides reason why it is not desiring coverage under the general permit.

(14) Permit by Rule

- Hydrostatic Testing
 - pH change from 6.0 to 6.5 to reflect the change in Water Quality Standards in 2010
 - Removal of the fee amount, replace with reference to the statute
 - Removal of the requirement to petition the CWC to reopen the Hydrostatic Testing requirement every 5 years

(15) Variances

- Established in Statute
 - General Variances:
 - Provisional Variances:
- Identifies the procedure and the required documents to present a variance request to the CWC
- Provisional Variances- events beyond the control of the permittee for a short term, time limited event and can only be extended up to 90 days in a calendar year
