


# New General Permit

## Background

- WPP is pursuing a variety of programmatic changes to improve efficiency & effectiveness
- Began with the small no discharge permit
  - <http://dnr.mo.gov/env/wpp/permits/issued/G823000.pdf>
- Next step is a general permit for small discharging facilities
- Allow staff more time to assist larger facilities
- Currently researching other states

## Applicability

- Privately owned facilities
- <50,000 gpd
- Multiple types of receiving waters; differences addressed through multiple effluent limit tables
  - Lakes
  - Classified and unclassified streams
  - Losing streams
  - *de minimis*

## Exclusions

- POTWs
- Facilities requiring an operator
- Facilities receiving industrial wastewater
- Land application facilities
- Direct reuse of treated wastewater

## Exclusions continued

- Outstanding State/National Resource Waters
- Wild and Scenic Rivers
- Ozark National Scenic Riverways
- Facilities with a TMDL wasteload allocation
- Within 2 miles of biocriteria reference sites, or critical endangered species habitat
