## Priority Points System & General SRF Regulation Stakeholders Meeting Summary Oct. 25, 2007

- Priority Point System

Staff will request the Clean Water Commission to approve moving forward with the rulemaking process at the Nov. 7, 2007 commission meeting. A public hearing is tentatively planned for March 5, 2008.

- SRF General Assistance Regulation

Staff reviewed changes made to date based on stakeholder comments. Stakeholders made the following suggestions:

Clearly state that “equivalency requirements” will be covered in the annual Intended Use Plan as well as define the meaning of “equivalency” as it relates to the SRF in the regulation.

Increase the dollar amount referred to in section (19)(B)2.(XI) regarding proposed construction contracts from \$25,000 to \$100,000.

Remove section (24)(A) as it relates to the Plan of Operation. Retain the “if required by the department” language for the Operation and Maintenance Manual.

Staff will revise section (8) Application Requirements, to ensure that quality applications are submitted and to allow for the adequate determination of priority points.

Staff will continue to work on revising section (20) regarding design/build projects.

Staff will pursue inclusion of language that encourages communities to include an I/I reduction and elimination program within their wastewater services organization.
