SUBJECT: Dry Fork Losing Stream Description in Table J and Kingsford comments

John, below are my recommended changes to Table J—Losing Streams based on the comment letter from Kingsford Manufacturing Company and our Losing/Gaining stream GIS data. Deletions are in italics and additions are in bold. There would be two entries for this water body. A map is attached. The total gaining segment would be 1.8 miles, not exactly 2 miles as is stated in the Kingsford letter. I calculated the mileage using the available losing stream GIS data for this stream, which according to DGLS, is accurate.
