Dear Operator:

Attached you will find results from the recent **lead and copper testing** at your public water system. Please note that you are required to notify users of them water system of the results, and include an information sheet on **Lead In Drinking Water**. **You are also required** to notify DNR that you did so. Make sure you do the following:

- Post the **Customer Notice About Lead and Copper in Drinking Water** sheet.
- Post a copy of **LEAD IN DRINKING WATER**.
- Fill out the **Lead and Copper Results Delivery Certification** and sign.
- Return the **Lead and Copper Results Delivery Certification** to DNR using the enclosed label within 30 days of receiving results.
- Failure to complete these steps is a violation of the Safe Drinking Water Act.
