CONSENT JUDGMENT

The State of Missouri and Defendant, James P. Vaccaro, Sr. ("Vacarro") consent to the entry of this Consent Judgment. These parties agree to the following.

I. Injunctive Relief

1. Vaccaro agrees and has provided the Department with documentation establishing that he no longer holds an ownership interest in the North Oaks Estates Sewer District wastewater treatment facility in Warren County, Missouri. See Stock Purchase Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

2. Vaccaro agrees and has disconnected the property identified in the Department's June 25, 2013 inspection report from the wastewater treatment facility that serves the North Oak Estates subdivision. See Certificate of Disconnection, attached hereto as Exhibit B.

II. Civil Penalties

4. Vaccaro consents to the entry of judgment in favor of the State of

Missouri for a total civil penalty of \$10,000.

5. Contemporaneously with the execution of this Consent Judgment, Vaccaro has delivered to the Assistant Attorney General, counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources a payment of \$10,000 representing the civil penalty by certified check made payable to the “*State of Missouri (Warren County)*”

III. Satisfaction and Reservation of Rights


6. Upon the completion of all terms of this Consent Judgment, including the payment of civil penalties, Vaccaro is relieved of liability for the violations alleged in the Petition and for the violations that could be alleged with respect to the management of the North Oaks Sewer District wastewater treatment facility serving the North Oak Estates in Warren County, Missouri, along with the other allegations contained in the Petition filed herein against Vaccaro.
