

2.3.2.4 Permitting Framework and Scope/ Permit Program Areas/ Industrial Sources/Special Discharge Limitations

Applicability:

Describes special discharge limits for industrial sources.

Content:

When specific EPA effluent limitation guidelines (ELGs) do not exist or secondary treatment limits do not apply to a discharge, Best Professional Judgement (BPJ) limits may be used. BPJ limits must insure that Water Quality Standards are met in-stream beyond the mixing zone. See Permit Manual section 5.3.3 for more information on BPJ.
