

2.3.7.2.2 Permitting Framework and Scope/Permit Program Areas/ Permit Fees/Modification Fees

Applicability:

Explanation of fee amounts and calculations for permits requiring changes

Content:

Modification requests to operating permits must be accompanied by a fee that is calculated at a rate of 25% of the annual fee amount, for example if the annual fee is \$100.00 the modification is \$25.00 ($\$100.00 \times 25\% = \25.00). Modification amounts are listed in the lower right corner of screen 13.1 in Water Quality Information System (WQIS).

Adjusted Design Flow (ADF) applicants are charged a modification fee of 25% of the annual fee based on the reduced amount. For example, if the design flow is 50,000 gallons per day (gpd) with an annual fee of \$3000.00 and the facility applies for an ADF stating the actual flow is 8400 gpd, the modification fee is based on the 8000 to 8999 gpd fee of \$225.00 resulting in \$56.25 ($\$225.00 \times 25\% = \56.25). This fee is charged regardless if the request is approved or denied.

The exceptions are MO-G01, MO-R10, construction permits, municipalities and permits that are reissued at the same time as the modification. Municipalities are charged a flat rate of \$200.00. MO-G01 and MO-R10 pay the full rate of \$150.00 and \$300.00 respectively. Modifications to construction permits do not require a fee.

Modifications are coded to fund 0568, revenue 1130, sub-revenue 08 in SAM II and WQIS.
