

3.3.1.7 Overview of the Permit/General Permits/Statewide GP Template/ Records

Applicability:

This topic applies only to the writer of the statewide general permit template.

Content:

Standard Conditions Part 1, which applies to all permits issued in the State of Missouri, includes requirements related to monitoring, reporting and notification, recording of results and retention of records. The section on records retention (Section A.7.) includes flexibility for the department to extend the normal retention period.

If the permit writer deems it necessary for a permittee to retain records longer than the 3 years specified in this section, then a narrative condition must be added to the permit stating the different requirement. An example of such a requirement would read:

RECORDS

All records of effluent monitoring shall be retained on file by the permittee for a period of 5 years after the date of the monitoring. This requirement supercedes Standard (?) Conditions Part 1 Section A.7.
