

3.5.10 Overview of the Permit/No-Discharge Permits/ Special Conditions

Applicability:

Special conditions for inclusion in permits issued for industrial, municipal, and domestic “No Discharge” wastewater facilities, and land application of sludge only.

Content:

Linked to this page is a list of Special Conditions typically written into permits issued for “No Discharge” industrial, municipal, and domestic wastewater facilities, and for land application of sludge only (see Other Links below). The conditions are grouped as follows:

- FOR DOMESTIC WASTEWATER LAGOON AND IRRIGATION SYSTEMS UNDER 50,000 GPD WITHOUT GROUNDWATER AND STORMWATER MONITORING
- FOR DOMESTIC WASTEWATER LAGOON AND IRRIGATION SYSTEMS ABOVE 50,000 GPD WITHOUT GROUNDWATER AND STORMWATER MONITORING
- FOR INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER LAGOON AND IRRIGATION SYSTEMS WITH GROUNDWATER AND STORM WATER MONITORING
- SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL SLUDGE ONLY LAND APPLICATION FACILITY WITH GROUNDWATER AND STORM WATER MONITORING

The link also identifies certain conditions that are optional depending on the operation or the site conditions. The special conditions also address WET Testing.
