

## 4.6.1 Application and Review Process/Completing Permit Application Forms/ Selecting the Correct Permit Application Forms

### **Applicability:**

Discusses using the correct forms when applying for permits from the Water Pollution Branch.

### **Content:**

When applying for a Missouri State Operating Permit, an applicant must fill out an application appropriate to the type of permit the applicant needs. According to 10 CSR 20-6.010 (2)(A), an application for, or for renewal of, an operating permit shall be made on forms provided by the department. There are many applications to choose from. These applications can be found on the Missouri Department of Natural Resource web site at <http://www.dnr.mo.gov/forms/index.html#WaterPollution>. The applications may also be obtained by calling the appropriate regional office. A directory is available at <http://www.dnr.mo.gov/regions/regions.htm>.

Below is a list of applications the department uses and the explanation of when to use which application.

Form A – Application for operating permit (primarily non-domestic waste)

Form B – Application for operating permit for facilities which receive primarily domestic waste.

Form B2 – Application for operating permit for facilities which receive primarily domestic waste and have a design flow more than 100,000 gallons per day.

Form C – Application for discharge permit – manufacturing, commercial, mining and silviculture operations, Form A needs to be included.

Form D – Application for discharge permit – primary industries, Forms A and C need to be included. This is for primary industries that include: Adhesives and sealants, Aluminum forming, Auto and other laundries, Battery manufacturing, Coal mining, Coil coating, Copper forming, Electric and electronic components, Electroplating, Explosives manufacturing, Foundries, Gum and wood chemicals, Inorganic chemicals manufacturing, Iron and steel manufacturing, Leather tanning and finishing, Mechanical products manufacturing, Nonferrous metals manufacturing, Ore mining, Organic chemicals manufacturing, Paint and ink formulation, Pesticides, Petroleum refining, Pharmaceutical preparations, Photographic equipment and supplies, Plastics processing, Plastic and synthetic materials manufacturing, Porcelain enameling, Printing and publishing, Pulp and paper mills, Rubber processing, Soap and detergent manufacturing, Steam electric power plants, Textile mills, and Timber products processing.

Form E – All general permits (MO-Rs and MO-Gs series permits), except for MO-G01s (see Form W).

Form H – Request for termination of a general permit (MO-Rs & MO-Gs series permits)

Form I – Permit application for operation of wastewater irrigation systems, Form B or B2 needs to be included for domestic wastewater, Forms A & C or D needs to be included for industrial wastewater.

Form J – Request for Termination of a state site specific operating permit.

Form P – For permit by rule hydrostatic testing of new pipelines.

Form R – Permit application for land application of industrial wastewater biosolids and residuals, Forms A & C need to be included; also include Form D or F where applicable.

Form W – Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Operating Permit Application

For land disturbance activities, equal to or greater than one ( $\geq 1$ ) acre, permittees must apply online, by logging in to: <http://www.dnr.mo.gov/modnrcag>.
