

4.6.5.7 Application and Review Process/Completing Permit Application Forms/ Permit Fees/Permit Variance Fees

Applicability:

Discusses the fee payable to the state of Missouri with each petition for a variance.

Content:

The term variance is not defined in the Clean Water Law or related regulations. Based on the normal meaning of the word, a variance is official permission to not conform to the limitations and conditions prescribed in the Clean Water Law and regulations. The Clean Water Commission is the body that may grant variances.

Any person seeking a variance shall file a petition for a variance with the director. The director presents the petition to the Clean Water Commission for consideration and action. The person seeking a variance must submit a fee of \$250.00 with each petition for a variance.
