

4.7.4.2.2.5 Application and Review Process/Review of the Permit Application/ Technical Review/Application for Permit Modification at Existing Facility/ General Permits/CAFO

Applicability:

This applies to technical reviews of construction or operating permit applications for modifications at existing Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs).

Content:

General operating permits cannot be modified. They can be re-issued at full cost unless the permit fee is waived for one of the reasons listed in 2.3.7.5 Fee Waivers for Modifications. Site specific permits can be modified for a fee as described in 2.3.7.2.2 Modification Fees.

Construction permits can be modified via a change order. There is no fee for a change order. The chief of the Agricultural Unit uses personal discretion to determine whether a change order is sufficient or if a new construction permit is warranted. Generally, if little additional review is required then a change order can be appropriate.

The technical review and processing of change order requests are similar to that of construction permits. If items in the construction permit will change, a new construction permit is issued with the original dates and an explanation of the change order provided in the letter. If no changes are needed to the construction permit, only a change order letter is issued.
