

4.7.4.2.5.6 Application and Review Process/Review of the Permit  
Application/  
Technical Review/Application for Permit Modification at Existing  
Facility/  
Other Permits/No-Discharge Permits

**Applicability:**

This topic applies to modification of no-discharge permits.

**Content:**

In order to modify an operating permit for a no-discharge facility, the permittee must submit the same application forms as were used to apply for an operating permit. The application should include the new information about what will change at the facility. Applicants should also be encouraged to provide a cover letter explaining exactly what is changing at the facility, as sometimes it is difficult to include all the details in the space provided in the application. A permit modification may be required if the facility is proposing to change the quality of wastewater generated, changes in land application practices, changes in land application location, etc.

If the only modification is a change in ownership, the current and future owners should complete and submit an Application for Transfer of Operating Permit.
