

4.7.4.3.1.3 Application and Review Process/Review of the Permit Application/ Technical Review/Application for Renewal of Expired Permit / General Permits/All Others

Applicability:

Renewal of general permits other than for land disturbance and agricultural chemicals.

Content:

Form E is to be completed and submitted by individual applicants for a renewed general permit 180 days prior to permit expiration.

Department permit writer reviews compliance history of the group covered by the general permit, reviews any suggested changes from staff or permit holders, adds any new conditions necessary to protect water quality or reflect new rules and requirements, and prepares public notice and fact sheet for permit renewal.

Following the public notice period and resolution of any comments, the general permit is reissued typically for a period of 5 years. Applications that have been received for renewal of general permit coverage for a facility or site are reviewed for completeness and changes from the previous application. The compliance history of the facility is checked to determine whether the facility can continue under the general permit or whether a site-specific permit will be required.

No fee is required at the time a facility applies for renewal of the general permit. Rather, the facility continues to pay the applicable annual fee. A general permit applicable to the facility is issued on the appropriate form.
