

4.7.4.3.2.5 Application and Review Process/Review of the Permit Application/ Technical Review/Application for Renewal of Expired Permit /Industrial Permits/CAFO

Applicability:

This applies to technical reviews of construction or operating permit applications for Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) with expiring permits.

Content:

Expiring general operating permits for CAFOs are treated much like new permits described in 4.7.4.1.2.5. In most cases, not as much information will need to be attached to the permit application as it is already in the file. Information should be verified, as it may be outdated. Some information may be missing from the original submittal as the required amount of permit information has increased over the years.

A new application and fee are required when a construction permit has expired before construction is complete. An extension request should be submitted 30 days before the permit is expired as described by 3.7.4 CP Effective and Expiration Dates, but reasonable allowances can be made.

The application for an operation with an expired site-specific permit would be a rare occurrence. The technical review would be the same as for a general permit. The review engineer must verify information used from the file and be aware of any special conditions as described in 7.4.1 Class IA, IB and IC Site-Specific Permits.
