

7.4.3 Special Conditions/AFOs and CAFOs/Class IB and IC General Permits

Applicability:

This topic is applicable to writing CAFO general permits. Class IB and IC CAFOs are eligible for general permits.

Content:

The CAFO General Permit is different from most general permits. The CAFO General Permit has an Attachment A that accompanies the permit. Attachment A is called the Detailed Operation Description and is page 6 of 6 of the General Permit. Attachment A contains site specific information that describes the operation (see Other Links below). The information in Attachment A includes animal numbers, wastewater amounts, land application acres available, land application needs and an additional operating description.

The permit writer should use the general permit Attachment template in drafting the permit. All of the information in the template should be completed. In the event that an operation contains multiple locations and/or lagoons, each location should be listed as a separate "outfall". The combined animal numbers and waste volume should then be summarized at the beginning of the attachment.
