PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2017 DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND INTENDED USE PLAN AND PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2018 PRIORITY POINTS CRITERIA

The purpose of this public meeting is to provide the Department of Natural Resources opportunity to present testimony and to provide both the department and the public the opportunity to comment on the draft fiscal year 2017 Intended Use Plan and the draft fiscal year 2018 Priority Points Criteria. The public meeting is not a forum for debate or resolution of issues. Opportunity to be heard at the meeting shall be afforded to any interested person.
