

CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION DETERMINATION

FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT IN THE CITY OF PERRYVILLE, MISSOURI.

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources has conducted an environmental review of the proposed project for the Perryville Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements project to serve the City of Perryville, Missouri. The proposed project was analyzed in the Engineering Supplement dated October 2, 2019 (hereafter referred to as facility plan). The city is located in southeast Missouri with a 2010 census population of 8,225.

The review was performed in accordance with the Department procedures for implementing Clean Water Commission regulation 10 CSR 20-4.050 Environmental Review and it has been determined that this project is eligible for a Categorical Exclusion. Accordingly, the Department is exempting the proposed project from further substantive environmental review requirements provided the project remains unaltered as described in the facility plan.

The following is a brief description of the proposed project and a brief statement of how the action meets the criteria for a categorical exclusion:

Planned Improvements to the Perryville Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) include the construction of new activated sludge wastewater treatment facilities with improved bio solids handling capabilities. The new facilities will be constructed near the current WWTP site on property currently owned by the city of Perryville and will effectively replace the existing 1.8 million gallon per day (mgd) trickling filter process with a 2.5 mgd extended aeration activated sludge facility. The new facilities will be located on the site in a manner that protects the plant components from floodwaters and allows for continued operation of existing facilities during construction transition to operation of the new facility.

In accordance with 10 CSR 20-4.050(2)(A)1.A., this project is directed solely toward minor rehabilitation of existing facilities, functional replacement of equipment, and toward the construction of related facilities adjoining the existing facilities that do not affect the degree of treatment of the treatment facility.

In accordance with the National Historic Preservation Act Section 106, notice was given to the State Historical Preservation Office (SHPO) and all tribes that may attach a religious or cultural significance to historic properties in the region that may be affected by this undertaking. SHPO determined that no historical properties will be affected and no tribes expressed concerns regarding the project.


