RE: Total Maximum Daily Load for Indian Camp Creek (WBID 212)

Dear Mr. DeLashmit:

Enclosed please find a copy of the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) study for Indian Camp Creek near Wright City in Warren County, Missouri. The TMDL was public noticed from November 12, 2009 to December 12, 2009 and two public comments were received. Having responded to these comments, the Department of Natural Resources (department) now submits this document as a final TMDL for review and approval by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region VII pursuant to Section 303(d)(2) of the Federal Clean Water Act.

The Indian Camp Creek TMDL was developed by EPA and the department's Water Protection Program to address the inorganic sediment impairment of Indian Camp Creek. This impairment was identified on Missouri's 2004/2006 303(d) list of impaired waters. This impairment arose from inorganic sediment being carried into the creek by runoff. The TMDL will be implemented through permit action and voluntary erosion control best management practices.
