**Meeting Purpose:**

An open forum for comments, questions and discussion on proposed 2020 303(d) Impaired Waters Listings and the data used for assessments.

**Summary of the Topics Discussed:**

- The Department provided an overview of the 2020 303(d) List format and organization and where to find the list. Staff highlighted links in the table for finding assessment data and a map viewer for locating proposed impairments and sampling locations. Staff walked through where to find the assessment worksheets that are attached to the pdf of the 303(d) List.
- The Department walked through an assessment of the recently approved lake numeric nutrient criteria.
- The Department answered questions and provided information on bacteria and other impairments in Cooper County.
- The Department answered questions on total maximum daily loads (TMDLs) related to bacteria impairments.
- The Department answered questions on TMDL prioritization and scheduling.
- The Department answered questions on permitted facilities in relation to new lake impairments due to lake numeric nutrient criteria.
- A comment was made for the Department to always include the 303(d) summary tables.
- A comment was made to correct the Department's website for the January 14, 2019, public availability meeting. The meeting will be held in Gasconade Camp Conference Room.
- The Department discussed uses of volunteer data, specifically how Cooperative Stream Investigation (CSI) data is used for assessments.
- The Department answered questions on the 305(b) Report.
