- Why discuss metals and PAH PECs
 - Stakeholder Requests
 - Body of Research
 - McDonald et. al. ; EPA 2005 ESB ; Mount et. al. ; DiToro et. al. ; Shine et. al.
- Results of the research provided to MODNR
 - ΣSEM-AVS/FOC
 - DNR will not be analyzing for ΣSEM-AVS/FOC in samples collected, but outline how that data could be used for assessment
 - What level should be considered potentially impaired?
 - <130 – Not Impaired
 - >130 and <3000 – Inconclusive
 - >3000 – Potentially Impaired
- Discuss draft flow charts for potential assessment of streams for impairments
 - TOC discussion
 - Seasonality – When to sample
 - During what season should TOC be considered for adjustment
 - Adjust samples individually by their TOC
 - Adjust geomean of samples by the average or geomean of TOC
- Discuss circumstances when both types of sediment data is available
- Only sieved sediment is used for assessment
 - Bulk sediment for screening only
- No change to assessment using PEQs with WOE.
- Toxicity Test requirements/constraints
