Missouri 2018 Section 303(d) Impaired Waters List and Listing Methodology Document Public Notice

Pursuant to Section 303(d) of the federal Clean Water Act, states must biennially submit a list of impaired or threatened waterbodies to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency during even numbered years. A draft of Missouri's 2018 Section 303(d) Impaired Waters List has been developed by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and is available for public review and comment. The public notice period will begin on July 3, 2017 and end on October 13, 2017. The draft list can be found at dnr.mo.gov/env/wpp/waterquality/303d/303d.htm.

An opportunity for the public to provide comments on the draft Missouri 2018 Section 303(d) Impaired Waters List will be held during the Missouri Clean Water Commission meeting, Oct. 4, 2017 at 10 a.m. in the Lewis and Clark State Office Building, 1101 Riverside Drive, Jefferson City, MO 65101.

Public availability meetings for the draft Missouri 2018 Section 303(d) Impaired Waters List and draft 2020 Listing Methodology Document are scheduled for Aug. 24, 2017 and Sept. 19, 2017 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the Lewis and Clark State Office Building, LaCharrette Conference Room, 1101 Riverside Drive, Jefferson City, MO 65101. These meetings will allow the public to ask questions about the draft 303(d) Impaired Waters List and Listing Methodology Document.

Submittal of the list to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is a requirement of the Federal Clean Water Act. The preparation of this list is also subject to the requirements of RSMo Section 644.036.5.
