Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in April 2008 and no WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted during the survey, and no comments were received. A picnic area was documented adjacent to the stream at site 1, and a house adjacent to the stream at site 3 was documented. Foot paths were also observed adjacent to the stream at sites 1 and 3.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No


Comments: The stream did not meet the depth criteria at any of the 3 sites evaluated. However, depth was found during the 2005 UAA at two locations, therefore, the committee recommends the WBCR use designation be retained. Due to evidence of secondary contact, the committee recommends Secondary Contact Recreation be assigned.
